## MENARD COUNTY UNDERGROUND WATER DISTRICT Minutes of the Meeting of the Board of Directors May 8, 2024

Pursuant to notice posted in accordance with law, the Board of Directors of the Menard County Underground Water District held a meeting at 2:00 p.m. at the Menard County Courthouse, 206 E. - 1. Board President Dr. Sheridan Duncan called the meeting to order at 2:34 pm after establishing a quorum.
