Purpose and Scope:

The purpose of this Annual Report of the Menard County Underground Water District (District or MCUWD) is to demonstrate achievement of the management goals and objectives in accordance with the District's Management Plan for the calendar year 2024. It is presented to the Board of Directors of the District (the Board) annually. The District's Management Plan was created in accordance with Chapter 36 of the Texas Water Code and has been amended and re-adopted every five years. The latest revision of the Management Plan was in 2022.

The enabling legislation creating the District was passed during the 71st Regular Legislative Session (1991). The confirmation election was held on August 14, 1999, with the majority of the votes cast in favor of confirming the creation of the District.

The Menard County Underground Water District comprises the entire area of Menard County which is not included within the boundaries of the Hickory Underground Water Conservation District No. 1. It covers an area of approximately 502,703 acres (785.5 square miles) in the west-central part of Texas. Land elevations within the District range from 1,890 to 2,700 feet above mean sea level. The total county population is 2,336 including the county seat, the City of Menard (population 1,606).

The Menard County Underground Water District is a local government agency, providing for the conservation, preservation, protection, recharge and prevention of waste of the underground water reservoir, located under the District; by consistently adhering to Chapter 36 of the Texas Water Code (TWC). The District conducts administrative and technical activities and programs to achieve these purposes by collecting, archiving, and analyzing water well and aquifer data. It regulates water well drilling and production of permitted, non-exempt wells, promoting the capping or plugging of abandoned wells. The District also provides information and educational material to local property owners, interacting with other governmental or organizational entities, and undertaking other groundwater-related activities that may help meet the purposes of the District. The District also strives to maintain groundwater ownership and rights of the landowners as provided in the TWC §36.002.

Goal 3.0 - Addressing Conjunctive Surface Water Management Issues (36.1071(a)(4))

3.1 – The District will hold one annual joint planning meeting with the Menard County Water Control & Improvement District No. 1 to discuss conjunctive use issues.

The joint meeting was held at the Menard County Underground Water District office on November 13, 2024. Minutes of the joint meeting are filed with the District's records.

Goal 4.0 - Addressing Natural Resource Issues (36.1071(a)(5))

4.1 – The District will minimize the potential contamination of groundwater by monitoring the spacing and completion of wells.

All new registered wells drilled within the District were drilled in accordance with District Spacing Rules, and maintained in the District's records. A list of all recorded wells and associated information can be provided upon request.

Goal 5.0 - Drought Conditions (36.1071(a)(6))

5.1 – Report a drought update will be given at least quarterly at the regularly called Board meetings.


Drought was of significant discussion during the summer of 2024. Water levels did drop slightly in the Water Level Monitoring Network, and the District worked with local citizens to mitigate issues, especially with shallow wells that had significant water level decline. Drought was discussed during the water level report at every meeting where a report was given.

5.2 - Publication in the local newspaper of a notice for need to conserve water once each month during times that the LCRA stream gauge at Menard has readings of less than 8 cfs for the duration of a week or more. The notice will include a link to the TWDB drought website at http://www.twdb.state/tx.us/DATA/drought/index.asp.

The LCRA stream gauge at Menard dropped to 6.5cfs during August 2024, however this does not trigger the requirement, as it was not for a week or more.



Groundwater Management Area 7: Desired Future Conditions (DFC)

The District shall participate in the joint planning process in Groundwater Management Area (GMA) 7 as defined per TWC § 36.108, including establishment of Desired Future Conditions (DFCs) for management areas within the District. In its evaluation of potential DFCs, the District shall consider results from groundwater availability models, scientific reports, and the conditions of the aquifer. Menard County UWD anticipates an update to the DFC in the next 5-year planning period, once the new model is available and acceptable by the District.



Financial Reports and Annual Financial Audit:

Financial reports are given at each meeting of the District's Board of Directors. An investment report is given quarterly. The Financial Audit of the District for FY 2022 - 2023 was presented to the Board at the February 14, 2024 Board meeting and was approved at that Board Meeting. The 2023-2024 Budget was approved by the Board in September 2023. Budgeting planning for the FY 2024-2025 budget in July 2024 and was approved after public hearing on August 28, 2024.
